

1986 Land Rover Defender Ambulance (Cook)	
Vehicle History	This Vehicle belongs to a family of three identical Land Rovers produced in 1986, all now owned by Electric Vintage Ltd.
	Manufacture of this Land Rover 110 started in October and finished in December 1986, built to a custom military spec for the Singaporean MOD and featuring a military-specific 2.5 litre I4 diesel engine build unavailable in other Land Rovers.
	This vehicle was dispatched to the Ministry of Defence Singapore in December 1986, where it served a non-combatant role patrolling parade grounds. We believe it may have been a prison van as it was very bare in the back!
	After a service life of 35 years, Cook returned to the UK in November 2021 and was purchased in November 2023 by Electric Vintage Ltd.
	*This land rover has undergone a full electric vehicle conversion, swapping out its diesel I4 for an electric motor and batteries (see technical specs below). On top of this, a custom food truck conversion has been carried out at the back of the vehicle hence the name Cook in keeping with our explorers theme. You can now serve food anywhere with 4x4 capabilities and zero emissions.*
